## **Pastel Painting 4 Beginners**with RON SHEPARD

**Supplies:** All Supplies are included to complete the workshop. Participants will receive the pastels shown below which consist of 64 colors plus a white and black hard pastel for sketching. Students should bring a sketchbook or notebook for taking notes.





**Class Description:** This course will introduce the beginner to the exciting versatility of soft pastels in creating a pastel painting. Each attendee will have the chance to use various papers, and pastels. They will be introduced to how they can use pastels to create a watercolor-like painting. We will be making thumbnail sketches using less quality pastel papers. Each student will receive a 64-color box of vibrant small square pastels as part of the package.

## Students will learn the following:

- a) how to make an underpainting using alcohol and/or water washes highlighting the dark, mid, and light tones.
- b) learn difference between hard pastels and soft pastels in hands on process
- c) learn the differences among different papers such as Uart, Pastelmat, Mi-Tientes Touch and Colour Fix. We will be using less quality pastel papers i.e., Strathmore to create thumbnail sketches prior to actual painting.
- d) learn different ways and when to blend their pastel applications and the possible objects to use when blending
- e) learn difference between a hard mark, a soft mark, and a broken mark
- f) learn how to paint a simple fruit i.e., Pear, Apple, or Orange combined
- g) learn how to paint a simple landscape
- h) learn how compatible this medium is with watercolor and colored pencils
