Cost: \$25 members; \$30 non-members **Description:** Learn how to use a bullet journal to find your best times to be creative and use them more effectively. What is a Bullet Journal? A bullet journal is a method for planning, organizing and tracking that is completely flexible depending on your needs. You can keep it simple or make it complex. It's up to you. If you use it regularly, a bullet journal will help you be more productive and use your time the way you want to use it.

Supplies: Bring a journal or notebook of any kind, pens or ultra-fine tip permanent markers, stencils and a ruler (if you have them), and an open mind.
