What you will learn:

The simple design of rigid heddle looms make them the perfect weaving loom for anyone wishing to learn the craft. They're perfect for all skill levels and allow you to sample a wide variety of yarns

and techniques. Rigid heddle looms are affordable, easy to set up, lightweight and portable. There are so many creative things you can do with a rigid heddle loom! The most common types of projects are scarves, placemats, dishtowels, or shawls. You can also weave fabric and then sew it with other fabrics to create garments or bags. If you have a stash of yarns from knitting or crocheting, those can all be used on these looms.

For this class, the looms will already be set up. I'll briefly demonstrate how to set up the loom, then we'll dive right into weaving. We'll cover color blending, creating texture, lace techniques, pick-up, knotting/shag and more. A wide variety of yarns will be available for you to sample and explore. You'll leave with a colorful sampler and a greater understanding of the weaving process.

All materials will be provided: dressed looms, weft yarns [in a variety of sizes, colors and textures], shuttles, scissors, tapestry needles, and instructions. If you have some yarns you would like to try, bring them along. The loom is provided for use only during the class.
