Robert's photographs are contemporary scenes but can easily be placed in the distant past as the landscape remains seemingly unchanged for over a century. Both Jenna Webb and Crystal Whitesides highlight the flora and fauna of the region in their different processes. Jenna Webb creates her imagery with linocut print making and green crafting focusing on nature, and more specifically medicinal and edible plants of the Appalachia. Crystal Whiteside translates her visions into eco-prints and mixed media works of art. Crystal finds inspiration in the constant beauty found within plants, animals, and the natural world, utilizing these elements to create worlds that awaken an unknown nostalgia within the viewer.

The artists' results immerse viewers in an echo of life in the mountain hollers, root them to our now, and give slight glimpses into our future.
