What exactly IS resin - and how do you use it?

What you will learn: This workshop is an introduction to the use of fluid resin as an artistic medium. In this workshop you will create a beautiful heart to hang using a wood heart cutout, glass gems, glitters, pigments to color your resin. Students may select colors of resin to use. After creating your art piece, it must cure for 12 hours

before handling. Finished work can be picked up Sunday, February 12th from 2-4 pm. Future workshops may be offered: a coaster set, a beach theme resin picture, jewelry from resin "skins" to name a few.

About Jacqueline: Jacqueline discovered resin art by accident. When the pandemic hit and we were all quarantined, she watched a resin video on YouTube and was mesmerized by the interaction of pigment combinations in resin, the inclusions you could use like beads, glass, shells, foils, etc., and the vast number of items you could create - both functional and artistic. Jacqueline has worked in acrylic, oil, encaustic painting, jewelry, awareness ornament designs and ceramics. Resin is the most difficult and costly medium thus far and her current passion.
