Call to Artists for Small Wonders 2024

On View January 20 thru March 1, 2024.

Southern Arts Society is proud to present Small Wonders art competition and exhibit. This is a judged art show with cash prizes ranging from \$50 to a \$250 first prize. Regional Artists are invited to show small scale works in a variety of media showing the difficulty and skill to create works of smaller size.

All work must be original, completed within the last two years. Painting (oil, watercolor, acrylic, pastel), drawing, sculpture, printmaking, and mixed media, are eligible. The image size is limited to 6x8 inches or smaller, mats and framing may be larger. Works must be framed, and properly wired to hang. Gallery wrapped canvas is acceptable.

Prospectus and entry form: is available at Southern Arts Society galleries and for download on our website.

Deliver artwork: Saturday January 13 from 11 am to 3 pm and Sunday January 14 from 1 to 4 pm. Early entries will be accepted during usual gallery hours.

Public reception: Saturday, February 3, from 6 - 8 pm. *Small Wonders* will be on display January 20 thru March 1, 2024.


2024 MEMBERSHIP
